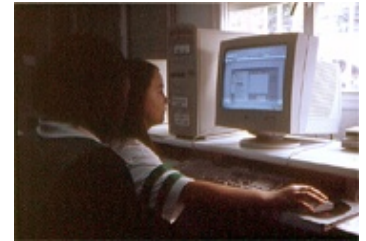




Summary Information

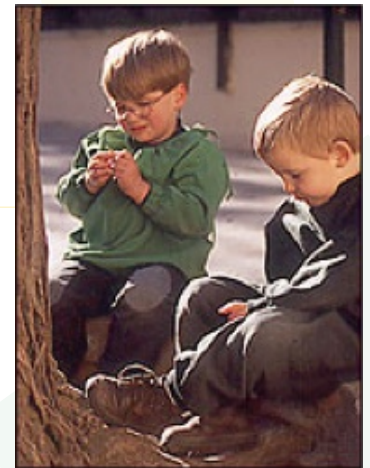


2. Curriculum

The school curriculum, which is based on the National Curriculum and obligatory elements of the Spanish curriculum, has breadth, balance and depth. In the early years emphasis is given to language and mathematics and as they move through the school pupils study a wide range of subjects. Secondary pupils have a good range of optional subjects to choose for examination study.

3. Qualifications

Pupils study for the IGCSE and Advanced Level examinations and also prepare for the Spanish university examinations. Academic standards are extremely high and all students go on to study in further education. Pupils' studies are fully validated in Spain.



4. Pupil Support

Pupils are offered strong individual learning support by class teachers and tutors. Individual learning support is available in the Primary school and there is specific help throughout the school in English, Spanish, and information and communication technology.
