Other requirements and accessories (only for Primary pupils)

- The official uniform and the P.E. uniform cannot be 'mixed and matched'
- All clothes items must be clearly marked with the child's name. This includes shoes, trainers, socks, scarves etc. There is a Lost Property box for mislaid items. At the end of each term, unclaimed items are donated to charity.
- T-shirts to be worn tucked in.
- Jewellery of any kind is not permitted (except for girls' small stud earrings).
- Nail varnish is not allowed.
- Children with long hair must wear it tied back so it doesn't get in the way during class or playtimes and to minimise the risk of head lice.
- Fringes should be cut above eye level or clipped back with a hair slide.
- Hair accessories such as hair bands, ribbons, elastics, etc., should be discreet.
- Hats and headscarves cannot be worn in class, unless worn for religious purposes.
