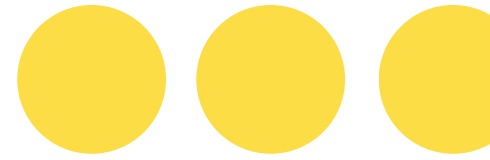
Our Extra-curricular activities programme offers a wide variety of options for our pupils to continue learning after school.

RELEVANT INFORMATION

What is the deadline for registering for an extracurricular activity? As places are limited, we suggest that you register as soon as possible using the online form on our website or from the communications you receive through Cognita Connect.

Is it possible to register my child for one month instead of a full term? For organizational reasons, after-school activities are offered on a termly basis. If you wish to register your child after the term has started, we will charge for the rest of the term.

Why does a long term (15 weeks) cost the same as a short term (9 weeks)?

The price is based on an annual calculation which is invoiced in three equal quarterly instalments.

How is payment handled? The invoice for extracurricular activities will be issued quarterly (October, January and April), at the beginning of each term, according to the conditions agreed with the school. Taking into account that we have not included the month of September in the price because that is when the students try the activities.

What is the price per term for extra-curricular activities?

The price is 169€ termly.

What is the price for sports with two sessions a week "e.g. Basketball/Volleyball"? The price per term will be 300€ termly for two sessions + Matches & 225€ termly for one session a week + Matches. Students on the competitive teams will have to purchase the corresponding equipment.

Is there a cancellation policy? For organizational reasons, refunds are not possible except for justified medical reasons. However, if your child wishes to change activities within the same term, this will be possible, provided there is a place available.

Are all extra - curricular activities in English? All extracurricular activities are taught in English. As we offer activities that are taught by other organisations, on some occasions, in situations of teacher substitution due to medical or personal reasons, it is possible that the teachers may not have a high level of English.

Do all extracurricular activities take place inside the buildings? Most of the activities in our programme take place inside the corresponding building, but some sports activities take place in the sports facilities we have, Bendicion de Campos and Azulinas use Colegio Mayor and Lorenzo Solano Tendero and Manuel Marañon 8 uses the sports courts.

Do students have to bring any specific equipment or material? For sports activities, pupils should bring the school's Physical Education equipment. For the rest of the activities, the school will provide students with the necessary equipment.

Do we federate students (Little Dragons or MMA)? For those clubs in which we can federate students, families will have the option, paying the corresponding fee.

What is the daily procedure? At the end of the school day, the class teacher will accompany the pupils to the classroom/space where monitors/teachers of the extracurricular activities will take them to their activity.

What are the opening hours for after-school activities? As a general rule, after-school activities take place between 16:15 and 17:15 (Paseo de la Habana, Bendicion de Campos, Azulinas and Sobradiel) and between 16:30 and 17:30 (Lorenzo Solano Tendero and Manuel Marañon 8). Check the timetable for each activity in the table.

Where will we pick up our children at the end of the activities? Parents/guardians must pick up their children at 17.15 at the latest (Paseo de la Habana, Bendición de Campos, Azulinas and Sobradiel) and at 17:30 (Lorenzo Solano Tendero and Manuel Marañon 8) at the entrance of the corresponding building.

What is the latest time to pick up my child? The school closes from Monday to Friday at 17.30. The time to collect the students for early years and primary will be at 17:15 and for secondary at 17:30.

Will there be activities in secondary school at midday? Yes, these activities will be free of charge for those students who have contracted the canteen service and as they depend on the timetables of our teachers, we will send more information in September.

CONDITIONS

- The school guarantees the quality of all activities provided by internal/external collaborators.
- For organisational reasons, extra-curricular activities are offered on a termly basis.
- The price is based on an annual calculation which is invoiced in three equal quarterly installments.
- The invoice for extracurricular activities will be issued quarterly, at the beginning of each term, in accordance with the conditions agreed with the school.
- Discount 20% from the third sibling doing ECAs in the school and from the third ECA onwards.
- For organisational reasons, refunds are not possible. However, if your child wishes to change activity within the same term, this will be possible, provided there is a place available.
- To go ahead with an activity, there must be a minimum of 8/10 students enrolled.

LITTLE DRAGONS BRAZILIAN JIU-JITSU

Fully based on Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu. The aim is to help children develop confidence, determination and discipline when facing challenges, while introducing them to the world of martial arts in a fun and alternative way—different from more traditional disciplines. Instead, sessions include psychomotor games designed to support the development of physical, mental, and athletic skills.

José Canto instructor and CEO of Canto Martial Arts, with over 15 years of experience working with both children and adults in the field of martial arts and self-defence. A Madrid MMA Champion and competitive athlete in the field of Mixed Martial Arts (MMA), he is also an official trainer for Spanish law enforcement and security forces. VOLLEYBALL

TABLE TENNIS

In this activity, students will discover the basic techniques of table tennis, developing coordination, agility and reflexes. They will learn the rules of the game, the types of strokes and the placement of the ball. Respect, concentration and sportsmanship will be encouraged. The activity will be adapted to all levels and mini-tournaments will be held to put what has been learnt into practice.

Term 1

- Learn the basic rules and how to handle the paddle.
- To learn basic strokes (drive, backhand, serve).
- Encourage concentration and sportsmanship.

Term 2

- Improve accuracy in strokes and movements.
- Practise playing in pairs and doubles

Term 3

- Refine serving and spin techniques.
- Play internal tournaments

FOOTBALL

In this activity, students will develop their football skills, learning the basic rules and essential techniques such as passing, control and shooting. Teamwork, respect and sportsmanship will be encouraged. Through training and friendly matches, participants will improve their physical condition and their ability to cooperate. In addition, they will work on developing strategies and decision making during the game.

Term 1

- Know the basic rules and positions of the game.
- Improving ball control and passing
- Encourage respect and teamwork

Term 2

- Work on shooting and dribbling techniques.
- Learn basic strategies for collective play
- Participate in friendly matches and team dynamics

Term 3

- Develop tactics and organisation on the pitch.
- Encouraging autonomy and decision-making in the game
- Prepare a tournament or final match between teams.

FENCING

Fencing is an extracurricular activity aimed at introducing pupils to this sport in a fun and safe way. Through games, exercises and training adapted to their age, they will learn the basics of foil handling, posture and movement. Fencing encourages concentration, coordination, discipline and respect for others, while also developing physical agility and quick thinking in an enjoyable and motivating environment.

The activity aims to:

- Improve coordination, agility and balance
- Develop concentration and reaction speed
- Promote discipline, respect and safety
- Build confidence, self-esteem and cooperation.

Term 1:

Introduction to fencing, including basic posture, weapon grip, footwork and reaction-based games.

Term 2:

Development of footwork, defensive actions (parries), attacks and counter-attacks through structured and playful activities.

Term3:

Consolidation of techniques through controlled bouts and friendly competitions, promoting confidence and application of skills learned

BALLET

This activity invites students to enter the world of classical dance, learning the basic positions, technique and body expression. Coordination, flexibility and discipline will be worked on. Musicality and elegance in movement will be encouraged. The level of demand will be adapted to each participant, promoting enjoyment and learning through constant practice.

Term 1

- Knowing the basic positions and body posture.
- Working on coordination and balance
- Develop musicality and artistic expression.

Term 2

- Improve barre and centre techniques.
- Integrate small displacements and dance steps
- Encouraging discipline and perseverance

Term 3

- Prepare a final group choreography.
- To perfect all the techniques worked on during the course.

MODERN DANCE

This activity is delivered in collaboration with Rosa Llauredó from **DanceesCool**, a dance school with more than 10 years of experience and over 1,500 students.

Jazz is a dance discipline that incorporates elements and movements from ballet, disco, breakdance, funky, hip-hop, blues, rap, twist, swing and rock & roll. Commercial dance, on the other hand, is a style that has developed through the adaptation of urban culture within the pop music industry.

At the end of the course, a Festival will be organised – a unique opportunity for pupils to take part in a large-scale performance for family and friends. This will take place in one of the city's theatres that host major musicals, providing a professional experience with stage sets, lighting, sound and a central theme.

The activity aims to:

- Develop body awareness, coordination and confidence
- Encourage creativity, musicality and self-expression
- Improve flexibility, strength and performance skills
- Promote teamwork and collaboration

Term 1:

Learn basic modern dance techniques and develop body awareness. Explore rhythm, space and expressive movement, while building confidence and creativity through improvisation.

Term 2:

Develop choreography skills and refine technique. Improve coordination, flexibility and musicality, while encouraging group collaboration and expressive storytelling.

Term 3:

Prepare and perform choreographed routines for the final show. Strengthen stage presence and performance confidence and reflect on personal growth and artistic expression.

ACROBATICS

Acrobatics is a dynamic extracurricular activity that combines strength, flexibility, balance, and coordination through controlled body movements. Students learn skills such as rolls, handstands, cartwheels, and partner balances in a safe and supportive environment. The activity promotes physical fitness, body awareness, and self-confidence. Teamwork and trust are also developed through group routines and cooperative exercises. It's a fun and energetic way for students to challenge themselves and express creativity through movement.

Term 1

- Develop basic acrobatic skills such as rolls, balances, and flexibility.
- Build strength, coordination, and body control through foundational exercises.
- Promote safety awareness and proper technique.

Term 2

- Learn more complex movements like handstands, cartwheels, and partner work.
- Improve balance, timing, and spatial awareness.
- Encourage teamwork and trust through group activities.

Term 3

- Combine learned skills into short routines or sequences.
- Focus on performance quality, creativity, and confidence.
- Reflect on progress and celebrate achievements in a final showcase.

BADMINTON

Badminton is a racket sport in which players hit a shuttlecock over a net, aiming to land it in the opponent's court without it touching the ground on their own side. In this extracurricular activity, pupils learn the basic rules, serving techniques, striking skills, movement and game strategies. In addition to improving physical fitness, speed, coordination and agility, the activity promotes concentration, respect for rules and teamwork through matches and cooperative exercises.

The activity aims to:

- Improve coordination, agility, speed and endurance
- Develop precision and control in strokes and movement
- Promote discipline, concentration, strategy and fair play

Term 1:

Introduction to badminton, including basic techniques and familiarisation games.

Term2 :

Development of strokes, movement and game strategy through structured practice.

Term 3:

Friendly competitions and consolidation of skills learned throughout the course.

YOGA

Yoga is an activity that combines movement, breathing and relaxation to support pupils' physical and emotional wellbeing. Through games, age-appropriate postures, breathing exercises and mindfulness activities, participants develop flexibility, coordination, balance and body awareness. In addition, yoga helps to improve concentration, emotional regulation and self-confidence, providing useful tools for everyday life. The activity takes place in a calm and respectful environment, promoting healthy habits and overall wellbeing.

Term 1:

Learn basic yoga postures and breathing techniques adapted to the age of the participants. Develop body awareness, coordination and balance through playful activities and relaxation exercises.

Term 2:

Further develop movement sequences and breathing exercises. Enhance concentration, emotional management and the ability to relax through a range of mindfulness and wellbeing activities.

Term 3:

Integrate the skills acquired through more complete sessions that combine movement, breathing and relaxation. Encourage independence in practice, reflect on the benefits gained, and share learning and experiences from throughout the course.

DRAMA

This activity offers students a space to explore artistic expression through theatre. They will work on improvisation, acting and character creation. Confidence, oral and corporal expression, and teamwork will be developed. In addition, empathy and creativity will be encouraged, allowing each participant to find their voice on stage.

Term 1

Learn basic techniques of body and vocal expression.
Explore improvisation and interpretation of emotions.
Build confidence and respect in the group.

Term 2

Develop simple scenes and characters.
Work on voice projection and diction
Participate in theatre games and group dynamics.

Term 3

Rehearse a small group play or sketch grouping together everything learnt in the course.

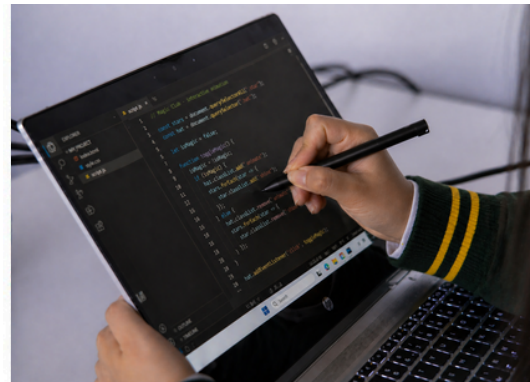

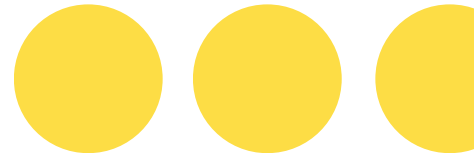
